



**TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, WEYMOUTH FOR WEYMOUTH
CARNIVAL, 16TH AUGUST 2017**

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF THROUGH ROAD WAITING OR LOADING AND UNLOADING

For the purpose of WEYMOUTH CARNIVAL, Dorset County Council has made an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation [Special Events] Act 1994 to prohibit the use of the following Roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except those taking part in the Carnival, on Wednesday 16th August 2017 from 5.00 pm until the conclusion of the Carnival procession (approximately 8.30pm) or such a time that it is deemed safe to re-open the highway.

[1] To close the following roads;

- [a] The Esplanade; from the Weymouth Pavilion Car Park to Greenhill
- [b] Greenhill [B3155]; from its junction Westerhall Road to the entrance to Lodmoor Park, Preston Road
- [c] Belle Vue; from its junction with East Street to The Esplanade
- [d] East Street; from its junction with St Albans Street to The Esplanade
- [e] St Alban Street; from its junction with East Street to The Esplanade
- [f] Bond Street; from its junction with New Street to the Esplanade
- [g] New Street; from its junction with Bond Street to the Esplanade
- [h] Westham Road; from its junction with St Thomas Street to the Esplanade
- [i] Gloucester Street; from its junction with St Georges Street to the Esplanade
- [j] Gloucester Street; from its junction with Park Street to Gloucester Mews
- [k] Kings Street; from the entrance to the Railway Station to The Esplanade
- [l] Astrid Way; from its junction with Crescent Street to The Esplanade
- [m] Lennox Street; from its junction with Victoria Street to The Esplanade
- [n] William Street; from its junction with Victoria Street to Dorchester Road
- [o] Dorchester Road; [B3159] from just to the east of Ricketts close (cone taper to take vehicles onto Carlton Road South) to Greenhill
- [p] Melcombe Avenue; from its junction with Westerhall Road to its junction with Greenhill
- [q] Westerhall Road; [B3159] from its junction with Melcombe Avenue to its junction with Greenhill
- [r] Preston Road; [B3159] from the mini roundabout and its junction with Bowleaze Coveyway to the entrance to Lodmoor Park

[2] No access will be available to The Esplanade from Gloucester Street, Westham Road, New Street, Bond Street, East Street or St Alban Street during these hours.

[3] Alternative routes for through traffic will be fully signed.

[4] As a result of these closures the following measures will take effect:-

[5] The one way traffic order in Custom House Quay will be suspended from 5.15pm to 8.30pm to allow vehicular access for businesses purposes only.

[6] The following One Way Traffic Orders will be suspended in order to permit vehicular access to certain parts of the Town Centre whilst The Esplanade road closures are in force:-

- [a] Gloucester Mews
- [b] East Street (from Mitchell Street to Market Street)

[7] From 5.15pm until the conclusion of the Carnival procession (approximately 8.30pm) there will be an additional temporary taxi rank at Coburg Place on St Thomas Street.

[8] The following residents and public parking places will not be available from 2.00am until approximately 8.30pm, or until the above roads are open to traffic:-

- [a] the west side of The Esplanade from the East Street to Williams Street.
- [b] the seaward side of Alexandra Gardens.
- [c] the east side of The Esplanade from a point opposite New Street to a point opposite East Street.

[d] In addition, public parking will remain at the Pier Bandstand car parking bays and along Brunswick Terrace throughout the duration of the event. However, there will be limited egress during the above times.

[9] For the duration of Weymouth Carnival and subject to availability, permit holders for Zones F and H will be permitted to park in any available pay and display space in the Pavilion, and Swannery Car Parks free of charge from 18:00 Tuesday 15th August until 08:00 Thursday 17th August 2017 (parking in the Pavillion Car Park will be restricted whilst the procession congregates). Parking will also be available in Melcome Regis and Park Street Car Parks free of charge from 18:00 Wednesday 16th August until 08:00 Thursday 17th August 2017.
